Big kids need boosters!

Did you know?

- More than 15% of kids 4-7 are in seat belts too soon, increasing risk of abdominal and head injuries.
- Kids' risk of car crash injury is **45% less with booster seats** versus seat belt only.
- Boosters make seat belts safe for little bodies: low on the thighs, crossing shoulder and chest.
- Boosters are needed until kids can pass the **seat belt fit test** (around 4'9").
- Consider a compact or travel booster for safe rides with friends and family.
